Chair of UUFPP Lifespan Faith Development Committee

Summary: The duties of the Lifespan Faith Development Committee (LFD) are listed in the UUFPP Bylaws, Article XI, Section 6. These duties include:

- The Lifespan Faith Development Committee shall be responsible for the overall development and delivery of the Religious Education program and other faith development opportunities for children, youth and adults of the Fellowship.
- The purpose of the Lifespan Faith Development Program is to nurture a sense of UU identity, foster spiritual growth, provide a foundation for a transforming faith, and cultivate vital, creative communities of justice and love.
- Both the Director of Religious Education and the Minister shall participate in this endeavor and have some of the responsibilities in this process as outlined in their individual work agreements.

Therefore, as Chair of the UUFPP Lifespan Faith Development Committee I covenant to:

- Support the DRE in children's religious education programming.
- Work with the DRE and LFD Committee to preview and assess curricula.
- Work closely with the DRE and LFD Committee to identify and support teachers for Children's Religious Education.
- Work closely with the Minister to identify lifespan education opportunities.
- Hold monthly meetings with the LFD Committee to review classes, programming and related opportunities for congregants.
- Attend the Coordinating Council Meetings.

Requirements:

- A sincere desire to educate children and adults in the principles, ideas, and history of Unitarian Universalism.
- An interest in all religions and spiritual traditions.
- Ability to organize committee meetings.
- Ability to track responsibilities of the committee on a month-to-month basis.
- Basic computer skills and regular access to e-mail.
